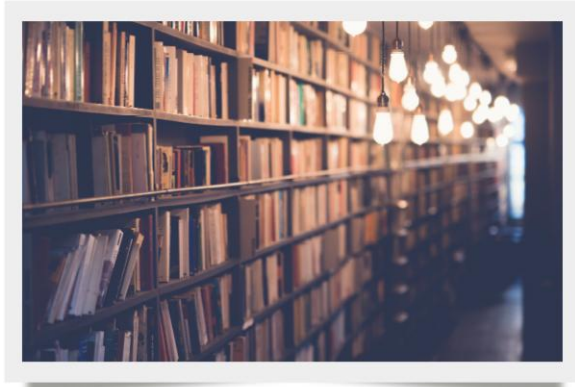

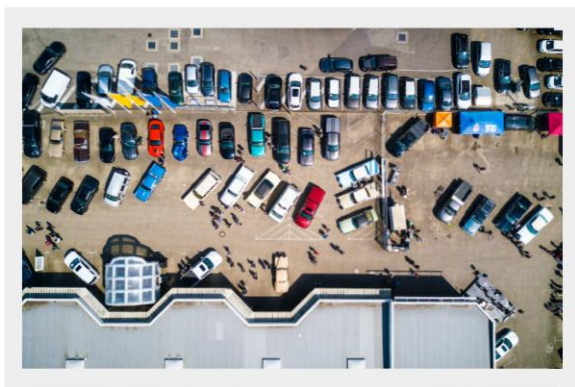

Is there street art in your neighborhood? What places can we visit? I'd like to see it! Well, this is the end of our trip. See you next time on another tour.


