(1866 - 1944)

- Russian
- painter
- one of the creators of abstract painting
- his most famous work:  
*The Blue Rider.*

**Did you know that Kandinsky had synesthesia?** Synesthesia occurs when you hear music, but you see shapes or colours. Or you hear a word and you see a color. Synesthesia occurs when you experience one of your senses through another. That is why Kandinsky could paint music!




1) What colours does he use?



2) What shapes does he prefer?








