  - adjectives to describe places: wonderful, amazing, attractive, etc.,
  - activities you can do there: swim, walk, surf, etc.
- **1 famous cultural / historical site**
  - name,
  - year of construction,
  - architect / builder,
  - significance.

**A.** Write a description of the country you chose using the brochure about Colombia as a model and the information you found. Do not forget to include natural and historical places to visit!

**B.** Pick the type of brochure you want to create (A3 size, flyer style, etc.).

- titles and subtitles: “Welcome to...”, “Places to visit”, “Attractions”, etc.,
- the description,
- a picture or drawing.
